WALLBREAKERS meets Urban Affairs in Berlin/ Stattbad, Berlin-Wedding

From July 1st through the 31st, 2009

Nobody in Germany has to be reminded: 20 years ago, in 1989, the Berlin Wall came down. A historic moment, also within the art scene of Urban Art. The Berlin Wall: 167,8 kilometers long, paved with torments, destinies, fatalities and at the same time, the biggest and most famous outdoor canvas worldwide. The WALLBREAKERS Festival 2009 wants to commemorate this historic cenotaph with particular exhibits of young artists of Urban Art. Within the framework of selected events and exhibits, REBEL Art is presenting talents from the areas of graffiti, photography, installation, conceptual art, painting and light performance.

Urban Affairs is opening its doors on July 1st at the Stattbad in Berlin Wedding. The WALLBREAKERS Festival will be presenting contemporary Street Art here until July 31st, 2009.

At Urban Affairs, the WALLBREAKERS Festival is presenting three artists of the scene: PETER FUSS (Poland), NILS MÜLLER (Germany) and ROA (Belgium).

PETER FUSS achieved worldwide recognition with his socio-critical and provocative big outdoor screens. His real name is unknown, his works are illegal in public spaces and he's already received a lot of attention on the international art market with surprising actions. Factor: absolutely worth seeing.

15 minutes and the train is freshly painted: in his photo work NILS MÜLLER captures the adrenalin, the time pressure and the adventure of illegal graffiti campaigns. He's been accompanying international graffiti crews on their nightly excursions for several years. His work documents the overcoming of barriers, the time pressure and the emotional chaos, the graffiti writers experience during their campaigns.

The Belgian artist ROA works exclusively with animal motifs, which he sprays onto large-scale walls in oversized formats. His "Animals" fascinate with their morbid impact, the clear lines and the strong expression.
